

A LOOK AT THE 2007 PLAYOFFS

2007 PLAYOFFS RECAP: The Ottawa Senators made their first Stanley Cup finals appearance in 2007, suffering a 4-1 series loss to the Anaheim Ducks ... Ottawa reached the final in 15 games, going 12-3 after defeating Pittsburgh, New Jersey and Buffalo in five-game series ... Ottawa is the only Canadian NHL club to have appeared in each of the last 10 post-seasons ... The club now has a 8-10 all-time series record in the playoffs ... Ottawa is the third straight Canadian team to reach the final after Calgary (2004) and Edmonton (2006).

ROUND 1 NOTEABLES: Ottawa (#4) defeated Pittsburgh (#5) four games to one in the Eastern Conference quarter-finals -- their first post-season meeting ... The Senators were 2-1 at home in Round 1 and 2-0 on the road ... 16 different Ottawa players recorded at least one point against Pittsburgh, while 15 different players scored two or more ... 11 different Ottawa players scored a goal in the Pittsburgh series ... Ottawa outscored Pittsburgh 9-2 in second period-play (18-10 in the series) ... Ottawa recorded a power-play goal in all five games of the series, going 6-for-24 (25.0%), while shutting down the Pittsburgh power-play at Mellon Arena (0-for-9, two games).

ROUND 2 NOTEABLES: Ottawa (#4) defeated New Jersey (#2) four games to one in the Eastern Conference semifinals -- their third post-season meeting ... The Senators were 2-0 at home in Round 2 and 2-1 on the road ... Dany Heatley led all scorers with 10 points (3-7) ... Daniel Alfredsson was on the ice for 12 of Ottawa's 15 goals in Round 2 series ... Ottawa was 3-1 in one-goal games vs. New Jersey.

ROUND 3 NOTEABLES: Ottawa (#4) defeated Buffalo (#1) four games to one in the Eastern Conference finals -- their fourth post-season meeting and Ottawa's first victory ... The Senators were 1-1 at home in Round 3 and 3-0 on the road ... Jason Spezza led all scorers with 8 points (2-6) ... Daniel Alfredsson had a series-high four goals including two game-winners ... Ottawa was 3-1 in one-goal games vs. Buffalo.

ROUND 4 NOTEABLES: Ottawa made its first-ever Stanley Cup finals appearance, suffering a 4-1 series loss to the Anaheim Ducks ... The Ducks became the first California-based champion and the first west coast winner since NHL clubs exclusively began competing for the Stanley Cup in 1927 ... The NHL's highest-scoring line during the regular season, Senators' left wing Dany Heatley, center Jason Spezza and right wing Daniel Alfredsson, also finished 1-2-3 in playoff scoring ... Alfredsson led all Ottawa point-getters with four goals and one assist for five points in the series.

LET'S TALK ABOUT SIX: The Senators set a new franchise record with six straight playoff wins (3-0 at home and 3-0 on the road) following their 1-0 win in Game 3 vs. Buffalo on May 14 ... Ottawa had outscored its opponents 18-9 during the stretch, which started April 30 vs. New Jersey.

HOME ON THE RANGE: The Senators were 6-3 at home in the 2007 playoffs and have a combined 26-22 record at Scotiabank Place in 10 playoff appearances (1997-2007) ... Their playoff home record by season is as follows: 1997 (1-2), 1998 (4-1), 1999 (0-2), 2000 (2-1), 2001 (0-2), 2002 (3-2), 2003 (6-4), 2004 (2-1), 2006 (2-4) and 2007 (6-3) ... Ottawa has four overtime wins at home in the playoffs, most recently over Toronto (2-1, 2 OT, April 18, 2004) ... The Senators have four overtime losses at home in the playoffs, most recently against Buffalo (3-2, May 13, 2006).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Senators were 7-4 on the road in the 2007 playoffs ... Ottawa had won four straight road games heading into the Stanley Cup finals but then dropped all three at the Honda Center in Anaheim ... Ottawa has a combined 23-28 record on the road over 10 playoff appearances in 1997 (2-2), 1998 (1-5), 1999 (0-2), 2000 (0-3), 2001 (0-2), 2002 (4-3), 2003 (5-3), 2004 (1-3), 2006 (3-1) and 2007 (7-4) ... Ottawa has seven overtime wins on the road in the playoffs, most recently over Buffalo (3-2, May 19, 2007) ... The Senators have seven overtime losses on the road in the playoffs, most recently against New Jersey (3-2 2OT loss, April 28, 2007).

ATLANTIC OPPONENTS: Ottawa is 6-1 all-time against the Atlantic Division in post-season play ... Ottawa is a perfect 4-0 against Atlantic Division teams in the first round of the playoffs having posted first-round wins over New Jersey (1998), Philadelphia (2002), New York Islanders (2003) and Pittsburgh (2007) ... Ottawa has second round wins vs. Philadelphia in 2003 and New Jersey in 2007, while also suffering a third-round loss to the Devils in 2003.

SENS ALL-TIME PLAYOFF TIDBITS: Through 18 playoff series and 10 playoff appearances (1997-2007), Ottawa has a 49-50 all-time record and 8-10 record in playoff series ... Of the team's 50 post-season losses, 26 have been one-goal games, including 11 lost in overtime ... Through 99 playoff games Ottawa has outscored its opponents 230-225 ... The Senators are 30-37 in the playoffs when they outshoot their opponent, 18-12 when outshot and 1-1 when the shots are even.

PLAYOFF POWERPLAY: Four of Ottawa's 13 game-winning goals in the 2007 post-season were power-play goals ... Ottawa was 18-for-95 (19.0%) on the power-play in the 2007 playoffs and are 76-for-473 (16.1%) all-time with the man-advantage in the post-season ... Ottawa scored a power-play goal in 12 of its 20 playoff games in 2007 and also scored a PPG in nine of their 10 games in the 2006 post-season ... The Senators are 39-16 all-time when they score a power-play goal in the playoffs ... Ottawa is 10-34 when they fail to score with the man advantage ... Ottawa's power-play is 35-for-255 (13.7%) all-time at home and 41-for-218 on the road (18.8%) ... Ottawa finished the 2006-07 regular season ranked 14th on the power-play (17.9%), going 72-for-403.

PLAYOFF PENALTY KILL: Ottawa was 87-for-99 (87.9%) on the penalty-kill in the 2007 playoffs and are 368-for-421 (87.4%) all-time on the PK in the post-season ... Ottawa killed 27 of 29 of Buffalo's power-plays in five games of the Eastern Conference final ... The Senators are 17-26 all-time when they allow a power-play goal in the playoffs ... Ottawa is 32-24 when they stop their opponents from scoring with the man advantage ... The Senators are 189-for-212 (89.2%) at home on the PK and 179-for-209 (85.6%) on the road ... Ottawa finished the 2006-07 regular season tied with Philadelphia for the ninth-best penalty kill (84.5%).

AFTERNOON GAMES: The Senators have only played five afternoon games in their playoff history, going 3-2 in those games ... Ottawa most recently defeated Buffalo 3-2 in overtime on May 19, 2007 (2 p.m. start) ... Ottawa also posted a 4-3 loss vs. Pittsburgh on April 14, 2007; a 5-2 loss at New Jersey on May 17, 2003; a 5-2 win at home to Philadelphia on May 3, 2003; and a 2-1 overtime win vs. New Jersey on April 26, 1998 (Alexei Yashin scoring the overtime winner, 62:47).

BACK-TO-BACK GAMES: The Senators played back-to-back games only once in 2007, facing the Pittsburgh Penguins on Saturday, April 14 (in Ottawa, 4-3 loss) and Sunday, April 15 (in Pittsburgh, 4-2 win) ... Ottawa has played back-to-back games a total of four times in the playoffs and is now a combined 4-4 in back-to-back games, 1-3 in the front end and 3-1 in the back end ... Ottawa went 1-1 at Buffalo on May 10-11, 2006 ... Ottawa went 0-2 vs. Toronto on April 13-14, 2000, and 2-0 vs. NY Islanders on April 16-17, 2003.

SERIE-US STUFF: Ottawa's 4-3 double-overtime win over Buffalo on May 12 gave them their first ever 2-0 series lead ... Ottawa has been down 2-0 four times -- in four consecutive series from 1998-2001 -- having never come from behind ... Ottawa is 7-0 when leading a series 3-1, most recently defeating Buffalo in Round 3 in 2007 ... Ottawa had never led 3-0 in a series until posting a win in Game 3 vs. Buffalo on May 14 ... The Senators have never swept one of their opponents in a playoff series but have been swept on twice (CQF vs. Buffalo in 1999 and CQF vs. Toronto in 2001).

SHUTOUTS: Ray Emery posted one shutout in each of the first three rounds of the 2007 playoffs, collecting all three at home (April 19 vs. Pittsburgh, 3-0 win; April 30 vs. New Jersey, 2-0 win; May 14 vs. Buffalo, 1-0 win) ... Ottawa has seven shutout wins and seven shutout losses at home all-time in the playoffs ... Ottawa has two shutout wins and 10 shutout losses on the road ... The Senators most recent shutout game came in Game 2 of the Stanley Cup final against Anaheim (1-0 loss, May 30, 2007) ... Patrick Lalime has posted five career shutout wins for Ottawa while Ray Emery has three and Ron Tugnutt has one .

WINS WHEN TRAILING: The Senators are 3-34 all-time when trailing after two periods in the playoffs with their last win coming vs. Tampa on April 21, 2006 (4-1 win) ... Ottawa is 9-22 all-time when trailing after one period of play.

ONE GOAL GAMES: The Senators have played in 49 one-goal games in the playoffs, posting a 23-26 record all-time and 7-6 record in the 2007 playoffs ... The following is Ottawa's one-goal game record against playoff opponents: Anaheim (0-3), Buffalo (5-10), New Jersey (8-3), NY Islanders (1-0), Philadelphia (2-2), Pittsburgh (1-1), Tampa Bay (1-1), Toronto (4-6), Washington (1-0) ... Six of Ottawa's seven loss in the 2007 playoffs were one-goal losses while all five of its defeats in 2006 were by the same margin.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

STATELY SENATOR: Daniel Alfredsson is the only Senators player to have played in all of the club's 99 playoff games. Alfredsson leads the club in all-time playoff goals (43), assists (37) and points (80) ... He is the only Senator player to record a playoff hat trick, recording two in the same playoff year (1998); 4/28/98 vs. New Jersey (4-3 win), 5/11/98 vs. Washington (4-3 win) ... With his goal on May 14 vs. Buffalo, Alfredsson had scored in five straight playoff games for the first time in his career.

ALFIE - THE ONE AND ONLY: Daniel Alfredsson scored the lone goal in Ottawa's 1-0 win over Buffalo in Game 3 on May 14. It was the second time in his career that Alfredsson scored the only goal in a playoff game that ended in a 1-0 score, his other one also coming against Buffalo at Ottawa in Game 4 of the first round in 1997. That one came in overtime. Alfredsson is one of eight players in NHL history with two such goals in his career, but only one of the other seven did it against the same team both times. Boston's Cooney Weiland did it twice against the Canadiens, both in 1929.

PLAYOFF FIRSTS in 2007: Joe Corvo played his first career playoff game vs. Pittsburgh on April 11 (6-3) and recorded his first points with two assists ... Ray Emery posted his first career playoff shutout vs. Pittsburgh on April 19 (20 saves) ... Chris Kelly recorded his first career playoff goal on Marc-André Fleury on April 11.

WORKING OVERTIME: Ottawa's all-time playoff overtime record stands at 11-11 ... The Senators are 4-5 at home during overtime in the playoffs and 7-6 on the road ... Ottawa's longest ever playoff overtime game was May 4, 2002 at Toronto when Gary Roberts scored for the Maple Leafs at 4:30 of the third overtime period ... The Senators have a 3-3 all-time playoff record in overtime games that last longer than one extra frame, most recently winning in double overtime (84:58) at Buffalo on May 12, 2007 (4-3 win).

EASTERN CONFERENCE QUARTER-FINAL GAME SUMMARIES:

Ottawa vs. Pittsburgh (Ottawa won series 4-1)

Game 1 - April 11, 6-3 win vs. Pittsburgh: The Senators opened Round 1 with a 6-3 win over Pittsburgh as 13 different Ottawa players registered at least one point. Dany Heatley potted the game-winner while Andrej Meszaros, Chris Kelly, Tom Preissing, Chris Neil and Mike Comrie also scored. Joe Corvo collected two assists in his first career playoff game, and Ottawa chased starter Marc-André Fleury with six goals on 36 shots. Jocelyn Thibault relieved Fleury, stopping the lone shot he faced. Two of Pittsburgh's three goals came on the power-play as Sergei Gonchar and Sidney Crosby beat Ray Emery. Jordan Staal also tallied a second-period marker.

Game 2 - April 14, 4-3 loss vs. Pittsburgh: The Pittsburgh Penguins bounced back from a series-opening loss with a 4-3 win over Ottawa in Game 2 to even the best-of-seven at one game apiece. Pittsburgh scored three third-period goals to erase two one-goal deficits as Gary Roberts, Jordan Staal and Sidney Crosby each scored for the opposition. Ray Whitney opened the scoring in the first while Ottawa's Jason Spezza, Daniel Alfredsson and Chris Kelly accounted for the Ottawa goals.

Game 3 - April 15, 4-2 win at Pittsburgh: The Senators broke open a 1-1 tie with three unanswered goals in the second period to win 4-2 and take a 2-1 lead in the best-of-seven series. Gary Roberts gave Pittsburgh the lead less than a minute into the game, before Dean McAmmond's goal with under two minutes to play in the first evened the score at 1-1. Mike Comrie gave the Senators the lead before Daniel Alfredsson scored twice put Ottawa up 4-1 after two periods. Sidney Crosby would close out the scoring for Pittsburgh.

Game 4 - April 17, 2-1 win at Pittsburgh: Anton Volchenkov scored on a slap shot from the slot midway through the third period and the Ottawa Senators moved within one victory of eliminating the Penguins by winning 2-1 in Game 4. Jason Spezza opened the scoring early in the first while Pittsburgh's Jordan Staal scored the lone Penguin goal in the second. Ray Emery stopped 23 of 24 shots and limited the Penguins to three goals in the two games in Pittsburgh.

Game 5 - April 19, 3-0 win vs. Pittsburgh: The Ottawa Senators advanced to the second round for the fifth time in 10 years after posting a 3-0 win for a 4-1 series win over the Pittsburgh Penguins. Ray Emery recorded his first career playoff shutout after stopping 20 shots while Dany Heatley, Antoine Vermette and Chris Kelly each scored for the Senators. Each of Ottawa's goals were second-period efforts as the club scored nine of their 18 goals in the series during the middle frame.
